Technical Meeting – Answers to Written Questions

NPC Greece	
Question	<p>We require for assistance to put the starting blocks for a Greek athlete Mr.Loukas Protonotarios Class T36 for the races 400m men and 100m.</p> <p>Rule 16 Starting Blocks Rule 161 4. Assistant for athlete to put the blocks for him. Track 100m M class T 36, if it is possible please.</p>
Answer	<p>See rule 7.13 Starting block may be set by the starter assistants, the appropriate form showing how the blocks are required to be set, can be obtained from TIC (see map no. 22).</p> <p>Upon request the Technical Delegate may permit an assistant to accompany the athlete onto the FOP to set the athlete's blocks. Request for assistance form can be obtained from TIC (see map no. 22).</p>

NPC Switzerland	
Question	Can at least 1 lap be run in before each start to set the lane regulator?
Answer	Yes, there is time for a warm up round.
Question	Is the track open between blocks (e.g. between 200m and 800m) for warm up, set lane regulator?
Answer	<p>The track can be used with a few exceptions (e.g. in the Long Jump area on the 100 m straight). Please show the necessary respect to the athletes in the competition and be careful because of the officials who set up the track.</p> <p>Before the morning session and the afternoon session the track will be open for warm up until up to 10 minutes before competition start.</p> <p>Please pay attention to the announcements of the speakers.</p>

NPC Netherlands	
Question	Is there a possibility to do the long jump with tailwind, probably the long jump pit at the finish. For a lot of our athletes is this competition the last possibility to qualify for the world championships in Paris, so it will be helpful to jump under the most optimal circumstances.
Answer	Due to safety reasons and to the time keeping, this is

	<p>unfortunately not possible.</p> <p>We'll use the middle runway along the 100 m straight in the direction of the lake (see map no. 18).</p> <p>For the VI athletes we'll use the pit no. 16.</p>
Question	Where and at what time is it possible to hand in your personal throwing implements?
Answer	Personal implements (max. two) must be delivered at the implement check (at the implement control, map no. 19) at least 90 minutes before the event.

NPC Germany	
Question	Can all athletes compete twice in the 100m event?
Answer	<p>Yes</p> <p>Heats on Friday per sports class</p> <p>Finals on Saturday (on the basis of the fastest times on Friday)</p>
Question	Can you adapt the pit on the wind conditions for LJ please to avoid Tall-Wind
